"India is a country of possibilities and possibilities should be materialized into opportunities which can be turned into realities by the youth of India."



The Commencement Day programme ended with a vote of thanks by Dr. Archana Choudhary, Coordinator, PGDM/MBA Programme.




Immersion Programme


Students enthusiastically participated in all the events and competitions. The energy and the level of intense competition shown by all the participants were commendable.







Table Tennis



POETRY COMPETITION





INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON GENDER AND MANAGEMENT: ISSUES AND CHALLENGES


n spite of policies and protests against gender inequality, discrimination, harassment, power struggle, good times are still not good for women. Even if the econometric evidence suggests that societies have to pay a price for gender inequality in terms of slower growth, the narrative of gender inequality in every sphere of life and management goes on.

A two day International Conference on Gender and Management: Issues and Challenges was organized by BIMTECH/BGU in collaboration with Institute of Public Enterprise, Hyderabad and University of Ljubljana, Slovenia, Europe on 5-6 January, 2017 at Hotel Mayfair, Bhubaneswar.

The conference aimed to bring together leading academicians, researchers, industry experts, regulatory authorities, research scholars and delegates from India and abroad to share their experiences and research findings. It also provided a forum for interdisciplinary research where industry practitioners and educators presented and

discussed the most recent trends, concerns and practical challenges faced by women in the field of management and contributed to the discussion on different aspects of gender related issues.

It revolved around five technical sessions apart from a panel discussion and a valedictory session. The conference commenced with the welcome address by the Conference Chair Dr. Parameswar Nayak, Director, BIMTECH, Bhubaneswar where he raised two debatable questions: whether gender has any influence on managerial effectiveness and whether gender or competency should be the determining factor in the appointment of women in the organized sector. He also emphasized on the gender role relationship and how it has perpetuated through social practices. He reiterated that in our age of technology, distances are narrower but the gap between genders is still widening. The percentage of women employed in the organized sector is far lower than men.





The keynote address was delivered by Dr Rado Bohinc, Dean, Faculty of Social Sciences, University of Ljubljana, Slovenia, Europe. His address was centered on gender equality in the corporate boards. He focused on dialogue on the various declarations regarding the realities of gender inequality which society faces despite the efforts. Rationale for equal gender representation in responsible positions has two major dimensions:

- Implementation of values such as human rights, equality, equal opportunities and democratic decisionmaking; and
- Better quality of corporate governance through consistent implementation of the diversity principles.


The Guest of Honour for the inaugural session was Dr Aleksandra Kanjuo Mrcela, Professor, Department of Sociology, University of Ljubljana, Slovenia, Europe. She stated that gender equality is the basis of modern democracy. Gender equality is to be valued and women today are well educated and experienced. She brought to the attention of the audience the quota system of Slovenia and India.

The Chief Guest was Dr. Sarat Acharya, CMD, NLC India Ltd. He emphasized that the organizations must not look at the physical ability of the candidate and must judge them on the basis of mental capacity. He said,


"While in politics, one must see who can mobilize the most votes, in organizations, no discriminations must be done on the grounds of success. Competencies must be seen in order to make an objective assessment and prevent the influence of preconceived notions and gender bias".

First Technical session was chaired by Dr. Rajendra Prasad Das, Vice Chancellor, Berhampur University and the keynote speakers were Mr. Satya Narayana Sahu, Joint Secretary, Rajya Sabha, Government of India & Dr. Radhe Shyam Pradhan, Professor, Central Department of Management, Tribhuvan University, Nepal. The theme looked into issues of skill, performance, recruitment practice. It intended to discuss the issues and challenges of boardroom imbalances.

Second Technical session was chaired by Dr. Parameswar Nayak, Director, BIMTECH, Bhubaneswar and the keynote speaker was Dr. Soumi Rai, Associate Professor, National Institute of Construction Management, Research, Pune.

The theme looked at women in leadership roles and focused on how this can be achieved rather than why this should be a norm. The next Technical session was chaired by Dr. Anup Dash, former Professor of Sociology, Utkal University and the keynote speakers were Mr. Jyotirmoy Bhattacharya, Country Head (HR) Mahindra & Mahindra Finance and Dr. B. Srinivas, Executive Director (Security), NTPC. This session examined the impact of gender on productivity, the wage gap between genders, life cycle stages, nature of work, women in police services and other issues.

The panel discussion comprised of eminent professionals from diverse backgrounds. The session was chaired by Dr. G. C. Patro and the expert panelists were Dr. S. K. Tamotia, Former CMD, NALCO, Ms. Bobby Patnaik from Infosys, Mr. A. N. Verma from NTPC, and Mr. Abhilash Mohanty from Google, Dublin, Ireland.


The panel discussed many sensitive issues like relation of family life of women and management, reasons of sufferings of women at workplace, exploitation at workplace, and equality. The lively discussion concluded with an unequivocal opinion that women and men are equally efficient at workplace. Women require flexibility such as time, adaptability and balance. Technical session four was chaired by Dr. Ashok Kumar Panda, and the keynote speaker was Dr. Rajen Padhi, Director, Utkal Chamber of Commerce. The session attempted to shed light on the financial and

marketing constraints faced by women led enterprises. There are not only social, but also family constraints for women entrepreneurs. It also looked into the training needs of women entrepreneurs. The last technical session was chaired by Dr. Nar Bahadur Bista, Principal & Managing Director, Uniglobe College, Kathmandu, Nepal and the keynote speakers were Mr Parthasarathi Mishra, Chief Human Resource Management, Tata Steel, Kalinga Nagar and Gopalpur Project, Odisha and Mr. S. N. Panigrahi, AGM, (HR), NTPC. Work-life balance was the major focus of the session.

Out of 200 participants, sixty five delegates presented their research papers in the five technical sessions. Abstracts of these papers were published in the proceedings of the conference which was released by the Chief Guest in the Inaugural Session.

During the two day conference, the participants had the opportunity of getting an in-depth insight into the theme of the conference. Dr. Parameswar Nayak presented mementos to the distinguished guests. The conference was highly appreciated by all the participants and speakers.

The conference ended with a Valedictory session. Mr. Ramesh Mohapatra, Chairman, Utkal Chamber of Commerce was the Chief Guest. Dr. Archana Choudhary, Convener of the conference delivered vote of thanks.
