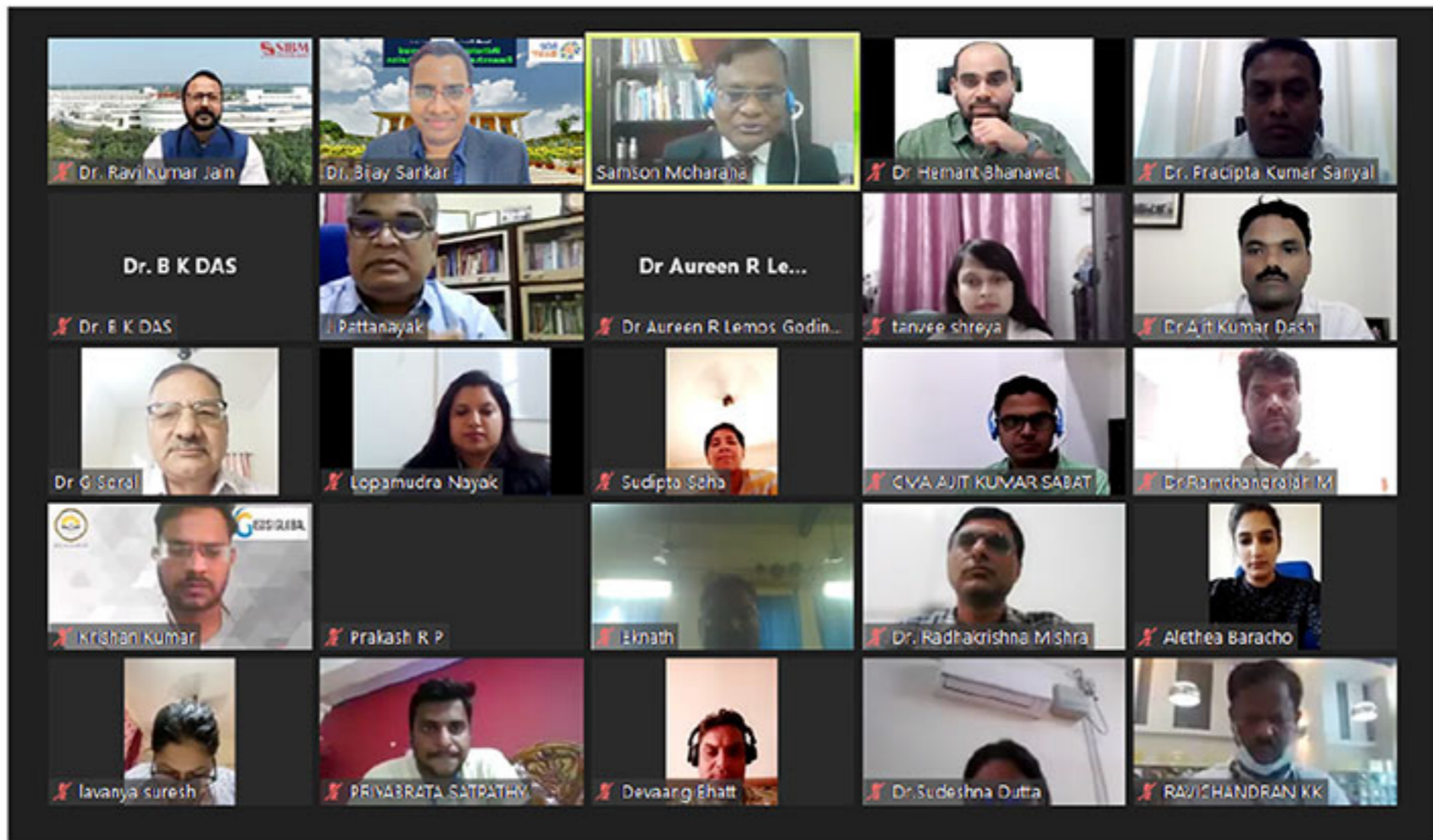


Birla School of Commerce organizes FDP
